









Curriculum information for Parents and Carers

<p>Personal, social and emotional development</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learning about personal care skills <p>Your child will be working on their PSED skills including their IEP targets across the day.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> RE – Easter – we will be learning about the Easter story and what it means to be a Christian. We will make Mother's Day cards and Easter gifts. 	
<p>Physical Development</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Moving Stories- dance to music and movement like animals in the hall <p>Every day we will during "Ready to Learn" participate in individual stretching programmes, standing time, stepping in walkers, bench sitting, long legged floor sitting, tummy time on wedges and SI SPOT games.</p>	
<p>Cognition/Mathematics</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cognition - Moving and transporting – when children move (or observe) objects or collections of objects from one place to another it helps them experience progressive changes in quantity, conservation and space, direction and position[e.g collecting cuddly animals in your arms and carrying them to the table] Mathematics- Measures <p>Focussing on SIZE using toy animals /pictures to order size difference-BIG/SMALL</p>	
<p>Understanding of the World</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mini beasts- learning about different types of mini beasts ICT – to operate interactive toys/iPads and other electrical equipment to make a noise/change to a visual effect or make something move.
