



Curriculum information for Parents and Carers

 Careers, jobs and uniforms		
<p>Communication, Language and Literacy</p> 	<p>This half term our sensory story is called 'When I Grow Up' by John Hayes. It is a delightful sensory story linked to our topic all about the various exciting jobs you can do when you grow up. There will be opportunities to explore various props and taste food linked to jobs. We will continue daily Look and Listen Stage 2 and Stage 1.</p> <p>Funky Fingers We will be completing some exciting gross motor tasks linked to our new topic. These will include pretending to be a lollipop man/lady linked to a scooter board activity outside and inside a similar stop/go activity using small vehicles linked to jobs. We will also be practising carrying a tray of pretend food items linked to a café job. Other fine motor activities will include lacing up shoes; using tongs to pick up objects and posting coins into a till.</p>	
<p>Personal, social and emotional development and RE</p> 	<p>Our weekly walks in alternate groups will be to Fountain's Road shops. We will be looking at what amenities we have on our door step and may venture into the shop further in the half term.</p> <p>In PSED we are focusing on wellbeing and choosing things that make us happy. The walk will be paired with this session as we know the outdoors helps our mood. The children back at school will be choosing favourite toys in a play and communication session with Michelle our SaLT.</p>	
<p>Physical Development</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> PE (gym) – This half term will be experiencing a sensory circuit and looking at increasing the focus and participation of the children in the way they follow a circuit. Using a timer we will try and stay at one station for a short period of time before moving on to the next. The children will experience moving in different ways and at different speeds. As always we will continue with lots of opportunities for physical development in our ready to learn sessions, outdoor play and SI room slots. 	
<p>Cognition/Mathematics</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In Mathematics our focus will be on 'pattern' linked to uniforms. We have got lots of fun activities such as making zig zag lines, checkered chef uniforms and making road marking using Lego. In Cognition our focus will be 'Collecting, grouping, one to one correspondence and 'Number'. We will be posting Numicon letters to the right house, collecting the laundry and sorting and grouping it. Sorting the recycling and making sure we have the right number of plates for a snack. 	
<p>Understanding of the World</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ICT-this half term we will be exploring lots of real-life objects linked to careers, jobs and uniforms. These will include a keyboard; a variety of telephones and mobiles; a pretend washing machine, feather duster, hairdryer, kettle, iron and a large doll to pretend to be a hairdresser. Science- In science our topic is being healthy. We will role play visiting the doctors and learn about being safe with medicines, we will choose activities to keep fit such as running, jumping and cycling and we will be trying water through lots of different bottles and cups. 	
<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> 	<p>In DT we will be making some healthy foods such as fruit smoothies, flapjacks, jacket potatoes with a choice of toppings and fruit kebabs. We will be role playing selling these items in a pop-up café.</p>
