

Communication and Language

- Children will use a variety of communication strategies as recommended by their speech and language therapist. This will help children to choose within the continuous provision environment.
- Children will also be encouraged to interact with adults through 1 to 1 interaction including Intensive Interaction.
- Children will join group sessions for some adult led learning.
- Some children will be using eye gaze technology as part of their speech and language work.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Children will be offered opportunities to play and explore together as part of continuous provision.
- Children will spend time with their key workers in adult led focused sessions.
- Children will have time to relax in the afternoon Ready to Learn and enjoy a massage or explore with sensory items.
- Children will continue to follow a daily routine which will include teeth brushing and hand washing
- Children will be encouraged to play alongside and with a partner in smaller group sessions.

Understanding of the World

- Children will play with a variety of toys linked to our Moon topic, this will include toys that are motivating to them.
- Children will be exploring light through Science based play.
- Children will continue to have lots of opportunities to explore the outdoors and other rooms around school.
- We will be doing some play with ICT toys and the whiteboard.

Physical Development

- In PD activities in the hall, there will be focus on our 'gymnastics, moving in different ways', this will include balancing on benches.
- Physiotherapy work will continue to be covered each morning in Ready to Learn and via nursery rhymes with actions in VAMP. Children will use a range of physical equipment to help their development including standers, walkers and bench sitting.
- Some children will attend swimming in the hydrotherapy pool.

Expressive Art and Design

- Children will have the opportunity to engage in a music lesson based on the Moon topic. Some children will do this as part of their VAMP lesson.
- Children will continue to have access to a range of sensory items in the messy play area.

Literacy

- Children will continue to become familiar with symbols and signs.
- We will explore a wide range of books including the sensory story 'Whatever Next'. Where we will join Teddy zooming to the moon.
- We will continue to develop our reading skills through symbols, OOR and cue of references.

Mathematics

- There will be a Mathematical focus on time, with an emphasis on fast and slow.
- Children in Cognition children will track items. This will include light up toys and big inflatable planets.
