

Communication & Language

- Children will use a variety of communication strategies as recommended by their speech and language therapist. This will help children to choose within the continuous provision environment.
- Children will also be encouraged to interact with adults through 121 interactions including Intensive Interaction.
- Children will join group sessions for some adult led learning.
- Some children will be using eye gaze technology as part of their speech and language work.

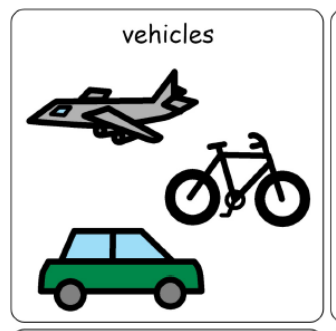
Understanding of the world

- Children will play with a variety of toys linked to the topic, this will include planes that light up and move. Train tracks and car tracks where children can track and explore vehicles.
- Children will have lots of opportunities to explore the outdoors and we will spend some time on the junior playground as part of our Enrichment Week.

Literacy

- Children will continue to become familiar with symbols and signs.
- We will explore a wide range of books including the sensory story 'The Magic Train Ride'.
- We will continue to develop our reading skills through symbols, OoR and cue of references.

Physical Development

- In PD activities in the hall, there will be focus on target practice and this will include games such as skittles. We will play with these activities in the outside area.
- Physiotherapy work will be covered each morning in Ready to Learn and via nursery rhymes with actions in VAMP. Children will use a range of physical equipment to help their development including standers, walkers and bench sitting.
- Fine motor skills will be encouraged in our art work this half term which will be encouraging children to create vehicles with junk modelling.

Mathematics

- There will be a mathematical focus on pattern through a range of sensory and auditory games and toys.
- Children will explore many cause and effect toys linked to the topic and find hidden soft pet toys both in the outdoor and indoor areas.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Children will be offered opportunities to play and explore together as part of continuous provision.
- Children will spend time with their key workers in adult led focused sessions.
- Children will have time to relax in the afternoon Ready to Learn and enjoy a massage or explore with sensory items.
- Children will continue to follow a daily routine which will include teeth brushing and hand washing
- Children will be encouraged to play alongside and with a partner in smaller group sessions.
- Children will take part in enrichment activities with the rest of school and a sports day event.

Expressive art and design

- Children will create some junk modelling based on the theme vehicles.
- Children will have access to a range of sensory items in the messy play area.
