







Curriculum information for Parents and Carers

Zoos and Safaris.		
<p>Communication, Language and Literacy</p> 	<p>Your child will be working on:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • developing their communication skills in all lessons • working on their IEP targets • We will be continuing Stage 2 Look and Listen and Michelle will continue to do a weekly play and communication session with Tigers. <p>Reading</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sensory story- This half terms sensory story is called 'Poo in the Zoo'. It is a hilarious story to help bring our zoo and safari topic to life! We will be exploring various switch toy animals, feeling oatmeal (pretend sand), exploring slime, spaghetti and lots more. <p>Funky Fingers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We will be working on our fine and gross motor skills using zoos as our theme. We will feed animal's playdough food, write tickets, use animal stickers, experience animal yoga and rescue animals that have been wrapped up and trapped. We will work on mark-making with both stationary and typing on the computer. 	
<p>Personal, social and emotional development and RE</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • RE-We will be learning about what it means to be a Hindu. This will include making a weekly Puja, washing statues of Deity in water or milk and sprinkling on rice and flower petals, and sitting quietly listening to Hindu hymns. • PSSED- this half term we are sharing home/school news. We will be sharing photos of what the class have been doing out of school. We will also be having a daily "Wow" time where we reflect on the wows of the day using the whiteboard to look back on pictures and videos. 	
<p>Physical Development</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PE. This half term our Tiger boys will be busy keeping super fit. Some of us will be swimming and we will all be going cycling to Wythenshawe Wheelers each Wednesday and doing rebound on our huge trampoline in the hall every Thursday! 	
<p>Cognition/Mathematics</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Money – Our maths topic is money and we have already started having some fun exchanging coins for toys and snacks in a pop-up toy stall and tuck shop. We are also matching coins, searching for coins in sensory items and doing some coin rubbing. Some of the children will have number targets that they will work on throughout the week. 	
<p>Understanding of the World</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ICT- This half term our focus is on switching and so we will be using the white room to control and change some of the equipment in there. We also have some very cute switch animal toys including a walking elephant and purple monkey. • Science - we will be creating sensory trays to sort animals into different habitats and exploring where they live. We will be learning about what different foods wild animals eat and making bird feeders, making salad buckets to feed the zoo animals and looking at different animal footprints. 	
<p>Expressive Arts and Design</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Art – Our topic in art is using natural materials and we will be using feathers to make a peacock, using leaves to create lion heads, making prints in clay and lots more. • Music - We will be focusing on rhythm in music linked to our topic of Zoos and Safaris, using instruments to create simple rhythms and practice stopping and starting. We will be playing along to "we're going to the zoo," using instruments that link to parts of the song and using the drums to create a steady beat.
