










# Curriculum information for Parents and Carers

		<p><b>Topic:</b> <b>Holidays (abroad)</b></p>
<p><b>Communication, Language and Literacy</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Reading</b> - We will be learning all about plane journeys through our story 'Amazing Aeroplanes', which explores the different aspects of travelling abroad in a multi-sensory way. We will also be completing matching and reading activities, as well as answering questions as appropriate.</li> <li>• <b>Funky Fingers</b> - We will be working on our fine and gross motor skills using holidays as our theme. We will be throwing paper airplanes, scooping sand into ice cream cones, cutting pictures out of travel brochures and mark making on passports and boarding passes etc.</li> </ul> <p>In both of these sessions, we will also be working on related IEP targets.</p>	
<p><b>Personal, social and emotional development and RE</b></p> 	<p>We will continue to work on our independence and self-help IEP targets throughout the week.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>PSED</b> – Our topic is old and new friends so we will have a weekly play session with children from other step 3 classes. Some of us will also be getting ready to move on to a new school so we will be celebrating our time at Valley by looking at pictures/videos and recreating some of our favourite activities together.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Physical Development</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>PE</b> - We will be attending 'Simply Cycling' and testing out different new and exciting bikes on the race track. We will also hopefully have a few trips out to explore play equipment in different parks as part of our PE topic.</li> </ul> <p>Every day we will use a variety of physical equipment during 'ready to learn' and break times to ensure we are meeting everyone's sensory needs. Some of us will also be swimming at Life Leisure pool in Hazel Grove once a week.</p>	
<p><b>Cognition/Mathematics</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Maths (Space and Position)</b> - we will be moving our bodies and other objects into different positions by exploring holiday clothes, toy planes, suitcases, deck chairs, a parasol, inflatables and also by making mocktails.</li> <li>• <b>Cognition</b> - We will explore diagonal and horizontal movements by rubbing in sun cream in different directions, making stacks of suitcases and sun cream bottles. Some of us will also be working on number targets throughout the week.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Understanding of the World</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Science</b> - We will be exploring changes in materials using heat through weekly cookery sessions. We will create a range of foods based on cuisines from different countries e.g. omelettes and biscuits.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Expressive Arts and Design</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Art</b> - Our focus is construction, so we will build a beach in our outside area, put up tents to make a campsite and use Duplo/other construction resources to create different buildings and structures from around the world e.g. skyscrapers and the Great Wall of China.</li> </ul>	
<p><b>Other</b></p>	<p>We are looking forward to our weekly visits the woodland area of Moss Hey's field for our 'holiday' to different countries. We will set up a campsite and take a suitcase with us to facilitate a range of cross-curricular activities.</p>
