Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Physical Development

- Fine motor skills will be encouraged in a range of activities this half term including tooth brushing, painting and playdough.
- We will dance and move to music in the hall.

Literacy

- We will explore a wide range of books including the sensory story 'Merrywhatmas' by Eion Mclaughlin & Polly Dunbar.
- We will continue to develop our reading skills through symbols, Objects of reference and cues of references.

Mathematics
