Admissions to Valley School are determined by the Local Authority SEN section following consultation with the school.

The children who are admitted into nursery are likely to be assessed for an Education, Health and Care plan during their time in the nursery.

Children admitted into Reception to Year 6 will most likely already have had their Special Educational Needs assessed and have an EHC plan.
