



<p>Communication, language and literacy</p> 	<p>Your child will be working on: -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> developing their communication skills throughout all sessions working on their IEP targets <p>Reading</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sensory story- 'The magic train ride,' Barefoot Books and exploring the different areas the train goes on its journey. <p>Writing-Funky Fingers</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Construction truck bin with sand and stones and toilet rolls Drawing with cars Painting with trains down plastic chutes Stop and go game outside Moving vehicles in different sensory trays. 	
<p>Personal, social and emotional development and RE</p> 	<p>PSED</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Our focus is on safety and we will be joining with Ladybirds for a play session alongside the Fledglings nursery children who visit us. Role play with Little Tikes cars. Turn taking games e.g. What time is it Mr Wolf? Activities and games promoting the concept of waiting. Role play - bus ride, crossing the road Car mat and cars for small world imaginative play

<p>Cognition/Mathematics</p> 	<p>Maths and Cognition</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Some children will start to explore one to one correspondence, collecting and grouping by using transport toys. Experiencing time especially fast and slow through a sensory massage story. Individual IEP work linked to maths and cognition targets. 	
<p>Understanding of the world</p> 	<p>Science</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Vehicle themed forces session experiencing push and pull including using the slide and swing, scooter boards and Didicars. Children will experience being pushed and pulled and have the opportunity to push and pull toy vehicles down ramps and on tracks. <p>ICT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will continue to develop switch skills in a switch and communication session with SaLT and OT. These skills will be worked on across several curriculum sessions throughout the week. Our weekly ICT session focuses on apps and games including using switches to operate the whiteboard, technology toys and apps on the iPad.
